I am excited to announce that we have nearly 40 people signed up to sing this year's concert already! This is an amazing turn out and should prove to be a concert to remember for sure. It is our 50th performance! As in years past we are asking vocalists to help solicit donations and advertisers for the concert program. This year's efforts need to be approached just like last year due to our new shorter rehearsal window of 5 week. Because of this shorter rehearsal window, donation and advertising efforts need to begin before our first rehearsals so that we have time to put together the program before the concert. Instead of a "promotional packet" of materials you have received in the past, you are receiving this email with attached materials to print to approach existing and new supporters.
